

# Regulation of best poster awards

## 1. The best poster awards

All poster awards consist in a diploma and in a sum of 500 € (five hundred Euros). Four prizes are available:

- Green Biotechnology
- Industrial Biotechnology
- Medical Biotechnology
- Industrial Valorization

## 2. Who can compete?

All posters presented during the Bioforum event compete for one of the poster award, provided that:

- the first author of the poster is a PhD student
- the abstract was submitted in due time to be printed in the proceedings
- the author is present during the poster sessions.

## 3. How to apply?

When registering for its participation to the Bioforum, each author has to select one of the three domains in which he wants to compete (Green biotechnology, Industrial biotechnology or Medical biotechnology). However the organizers can shift a poster to another domain if its content justify this shift. All posters automatically compete also for the Industrial Valorization award. An abstract of the poster should be uploaded to complete the registration.

## 4. Abstract format

One A4 page, with all margins set at 2.5 cm.

Title: Times New Roman police with a size of 14, bold letters.

Author list, affiliation and summary: Times New Roman police with a size of 12, normal letters. Do not include any figure, nor any reference.

## 5. How is made the evaluation?

For each price, the organizers create a jury of minimum three independent persons including a president. Each jury member will examine the posters in its domain during the posters sessions. Poster authors should be physically present during these sessions. Jury members will evaluate the poster (quality of the research, of the abstract, of the poster itself), but they can also ask questions to the author. Each jury member give a mark and the price will be attributed to the poster with the highest average mark. In case of a tie, the marks of the president will separate the posters.

A poster cannot be awarded two prices.

In case no poster is of sufficient quality in one of the domains, the jury in charge of the evaluation can decide to not give this price.

## 6. Award announcement

The awards will be presented at the end of the Bioforum event. Each laureate will receive the sum of 500 € and a diploma signed at least by one of jury members or one organizers. He will have to sign a receipt. The awards will also be advertised on the Bioforum and on the BioLiège websites.
